The steel blades are arranged in a fan-shape to maximize the impact surface while offering excellent flexibility. Their width of 45 cm and height of 34 cm ensure effective coverage of ground-level flames.

Long, ergonomic handle

The **150 cm wooden handle** ensures good reach while reducing operator exposure to heat and smoke. Its length offers optimum leverage, limiting muscle fatigue during prolonged operations.
