The **"Sapeur-Pompier" model backfill rake,** also known as the **Riche rake**, is designed for forest, brush or edge fire-fighting operations. In particular, it is used to create firebreaks, stir up embers or safely remove debris.

Tried and tested by forestry brigades and wildfire intervention units, it combines efficiency, grip and durability.

Robust, ergonomic design

This model features **4 sharp**, hardened steel tines, ideal for snagging roots, vegetation or embers that are still active. The **130 cm long wooden handle** ensures good leverage and allows you to work for longer periods while maintaining a comfortable posture.

Its simple, yet ultra-functional design makes it perfectly suited to forestry or agricultural environments.
