

SKED basic Orange rescue stretcher

The Sked Basic Rescue System stretcher is the reference tool for technical rescue missions. Made from durable molded plastic, it offers complete protection for the patient, while enabling both horizontal and vertical extractions (e.g. from caves, reservoirs or technical shafts). Its innovative design allows it to be rolled for storage, and once the patient is placed inside with the straps, it becomes rigid - ensuring stable transport in tight spaces.

Each system includes not only the Sked stretcher itself in bright orange for optimum visibility, but also a Cordura backpack for transport, horizontal lifting straps, a vertical strap, sturdy handles, a Tow Strap and a steel "D" carabiner for secure attachment. The whole package weighs in at around 7.7 kg, which is well contained considering its comprehensive capabilities.

Thanks to its Steel Buckles finish, this model provides a sturdy, durable, corrosion-resistant closure, suitable for damp or weather-exposed environments. The integrated strap system ensures that the patient is held correctly, even during inclines or vertical lifts, minimizing damaging internal movements for injured patients.

Benefits and highlights

The Sked Basic Rescue System stands out for its versatility and strength. Its main asset is its ability to be used in difficult scenarios: confined spaces, heights, technical interventions or rugged terrain. The fact that it can become rigid when the patient is appropriate enhances control and safety during transport.

International orange visibility means you'll be able to spot it quickly when you need it, even in the dark. The Cordura bag makes transporting the equipment easier, protects the device and enables rapid mobilization. Metal fasteners and multiple handles ensure a stable, reliable hold.

Recommended uses

This stretcher is particularly well-suited to rescue teams, firefighters, mountain operations, extraction missions in confined spaces, underground search operations and natural disasters. It is also suitable for military or civilian use in harsh environments where maneuverability and robustness are essential.

It is useful in cases of vertical evacuation, winching, difficult access, or any situation where the stretcher has to pass through narrow openings. The included bag allows easy transport in a vehicle or on the back for field teams.

Compatibility

The complete system is designed to operate as a stand-alone unit. Recommended components include :

- Horizontal and vertical lifting straps included.
- Cordura bag supplied for transport.
- Multiple carrying handles for handling by several rescuers.
- Steel "D" carabiner for anchoring points.

No external accessories are strictly necessary, but compatible accessories such as harnesses or head immobilizers can be used in addition.

Technical specifications

The system weighs approx. 7.7 kg complete, including stretcher, bag, straps and fasteners. Molded plastic provides rigidity and durability. Steel buckles ensure reliable fastening. Rolled storage size: compact enough to be carried in the supplied bag. Tear- and abrasion-resistant Cordura bag.

FAQ - Frequently asked questions

Can the stretcher be used for vertical lifts?

Yes, the Sked Basic Rescue System can be used for vertical or horizontal lifts, thanks to the horizontal/vertical straps included.

Is the bag included?

Yes, the Cordura storage bag is included in the complete package.

What kind of fasteners are used?

This model uses Steel Buckles, which are highly resistant to stress and corrosion.

Can it be used in wet or marine environments?

Yes, the material and components are designed to tolerate moisture, splashes or demanding conditions, although rinsing after use is recommended.

What is the total weight?

The complete system weighs around 7.7 kg (?17 lb) with all accessories. This is still reasonable for field use with several rescuers.

Delivery terms

Delivery for the Sked Basic Rescue System is from our warehouse. Estimated delivery times in mainland France are 2 to 6 working days after order confirmation, depending on stock availability.
