

Replacement head for the KERi manikin



The replacement head for the KERi “ manikin ” is a spare part designed to replace the head of a KERi “ manikin ” used in nursing education. It keeps the “ manikin ” in working order when the original head needs to be replaced.

This part is intended for training centers, healthcare schools, healthcare facilities, and organizations that use the KERi manikin to teach basic care procedures, hygiene, patient positioning, or clinical simulation.

FAQ – Replacement Head for the KERi manikin

What is this replacement head used for?

It is used to replace the head of a KERi “ manikin ” used in nursing training, in order to keep the “ manikin ” in working condition for educational purposes.

Does this part replace the entire KERi manikin?

No. It is only a **replacement head**. It allows you to replace this part of the manikin without replacing the entire unit.

In what situations should this replacement part be used?

It is useful when a KERi “ manikin ” is used regularly in training and the original head needs to be replaced to maintain a clean, functional, and presentable teaching aid.
